

Life is ONLY In The Resurrection Part 2

Who? – When? - How?

1 Corinthians 15:3 For what I received I passed on to you **as of first importance**: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, **4** that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

Genesis 3:21 The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them. **22** And the LORD God said, "The man has now become like one of us, knowing good and evil. He must not be allowed to reach out his hand and take also from the tree of life and eat, and live forever." **23** So the LORD God banished him from the Garden of Eden to work the ground from which he had been taken. **24** After he drove the man out, he placed on the east side of the Garden of Eden cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life.

Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you (*satan*) and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he (*Christ*) will crush your head, and you (*satan*) will strike his heel."

(KJV)15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and **her seed**; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Galatians 3:16 The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say "and to seeds," meaning many people, but "and to your seed,"meaning one person, who is Christ.

John3:13 No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man. **14 Just as** Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, **15** that everyone who believes in him may have eternal (*aion-age lasting*) life.

Numbers 21:6 Then the LORD sent venomous snakes among them; they bit the people and many Israelites died. **7** The people came to Moses and said, "**We sinned** when we spoke against the LORD **and against you.** Pray that the LORD will take the snakes away from us." So Moses prayed for the people.

Numbers 21:8 The LORD said to Moses, "Make a snake and put it up on a pole; anyone who is bitten **can look at it and live.**"

9 So Moses made a bronze snake and put it up on a pole. Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and **looked** at the bronze snake, he **lived**.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek (*Gentile*), slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 15:17 And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. **18** Then those also who have **fallen asleep** in Christ are lost.

20 But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have **fallen asleep.**

51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all **sleep**, (*some will be still living when He returns*) but we will **all be changed**—

2 Corinthians 5:1 Now we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in (*from*) heaven, not built by human hands. **2**

Meanwhile we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, **3** because when we are clothed, we will not be found naked. **4** For while we are in this tent, we groan and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.

Job 14:12 so man lies down and does not rise; till the heavens are no more, men will not awake or be roused from their sleep. **13** "If only you would hide me in the grave and conceal me till your anger has passed! If only you would set me a time and then remember me!

14 If a man dies, will he live again? All the days of my hard service I will wait for my renewal to come. **15** You will call and I will answer you; you will long for the creature your hands have made.

Daniel 12:1 (ESV) 1"At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. **2 And many** (*NOT ALL*) of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, **some** to everlasting (*aion, age-lasting*) life, **and some** to shame and everlasting (*aion, age-lasting*) contempt.

(NLT) 2 Many of those whose bodies lie dead and buried will rise up, some to everlasting (*aion, age-lasting*) life and some to shame and everlasting (*aion, age-lasting*) disgrace.
