***Strategy**, a word of [military](#) origin, refers to a plan of action designed to achieve a particular [goal](#). In [military usage](#) strategy is distinct from [tactics](#), which are concerned with the conduct of an engagement, while strategy is concerned with how different engagements are linked. How a battle is fought is a matter of tactics: the terms and conditions that it is fought on and whether it should be fought at all is a matter of strategy, which is part of the four levels of warfare: political goals or [grand strategy](#), strategy, [operations](#), and tactics.*

*A **tactic** is a conceptual action. In military usage, a [military tactic](#) is used by a [military unit](#) of no larger than a [division](#) to implement a specific mission and achieve a specific objective, or to advance toward a specific goal. A tactic is implemented as one or more tasks.*

Romans 1:⁷To all those in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints:

There's a great start—The saints--HE REDEEMED of God! Now don't let me stop at each one or we will be here all day!

1 Corinthians 1:²To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours:

2 Corinthians 1:¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, To the church of God that is at Corinth, with all the saints who are in the whole of Achaia:

Galatians 1:¹Paul, an apostle— not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead— ²and all the brothers who are with me,

Ephesians 1:¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus:

Philippians 1: ¹Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons:

Colossians 1: ¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, ²To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae:

1 Thessalonians 1: ¹Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

2 Thessalonians 1: ¹ Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

Romans 15: ⁴For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

1 Corinthians 10: ¹¹Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come.

1 Corinthians 10: ³² Give no offense to **Jews** or to **Greeks** (*Gentiles*) or to the **church of God,**

1 Timothy 1: ¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope, ²To Timothy, my true child in the faith:

2 Timothy 2: ¹Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God according to the promise of the life that is in Christ Jesus, ²To Timothy, my beloved child:

Titus 1: ⁴To Titus, my true child in a common faith:

Philemon 1: ¹Paul, a prisoner for Christ Jesus, and Timothy our brother, To Philemon our beloved fellow worker ²and Apphia our sister and Archippus our fellow soldier, and the church in your house: ³ Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 1: ¹Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, ²but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

James 1: ¹ James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes in the Dispersion:

1 Peter 1: ¹Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who are elect exiles of the dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,

2 Peter 1: ¹Simeon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have obtained a faith of equal standing with ours by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:

1 John 1: ³ that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. ⁴And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

2 John 1: ¹ The elder to the elect lady and her children, whom I love in truth, and not only I, but also all who know the truth, ² because of the truth that abides in us and will be with us forever:

3 John 1: ¹ The elder to the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth.

Jude 1: ¹Jude, a servant of Jesus Christ and brother of James, To those who are called, beloved in God the Father and kept for Jesus Christ:

Revelation 1:¹The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants (*doulos-bond servants*) the things that must soon take place. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John,

² who bore witness to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw. ³ Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near. ⁴ John to the seven churches that are in Asia:

1 Corinthians 9:¹⁸What then is my reward? That in my preaching I may present **the gospel** free of charge, so as not to make full use of my right in **the gospel**. ¹⁹For though I am free from all, I have made myself **a servant to all**, that I might **win** more **OF THEM**. ²⁰To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to **win** Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law (though not being myself under the law) that I might win those under the law. ²¹To those outside the law I became as one outside the law (not being outside the law of God but under the law of Christ) that I might **win** those outside the law. ²² To the weak I became weak, that I might **win** the weak. I have become all things to all people, that by all means I **might save some**. ²³I do it all for the sake of **the gospel**, that I **MAY SHARE** (*aojist middle-subjunctive*) with them in its blessings.

May Share:

Aorist- undefined as to the progress or the completion of the action

Middle-the subject as acting with reference to himself.

Subjunctive-expresses the idea of probable completion of the action of the verb with the possibility of the action of the verb failing to be completed

2 Timothy 2: ⁸Remember Jesus Christ (*the Messiah*), risen from the dead, the offspring of David, **AS** preached in my gospel, ⁹for which I am suffering, bound with chains as a criminal. But the word of God is not bound! ¹⁰Therefore I endure everything for the sake of **THE ELECT**, that they also **MAY obtain** (*aorist-active-subjunctive*) **the salvation** that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

May Obtain: *Aorist-* undefined as to the progress or the completion of the action. *Active-* the subject is acting. *Subjunctive-* expresses the idea of probable completion of the action of the verb **with the possibility** of the action of the verb **failing to be completed**.
