2 Corinthians 11: ³But I am afraid that as the serpent **deceived** Eve **by his cunning**, **your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ.** (*The Messiah*) ⁴For **IF** someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than **the ONE** we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit from **the ONE** you received, or if you accept a different gospel from **the ONE** you accepted, you put up with it readily enough. ⁵Indeed, I consider that I am not in the least inferior to these super-apostles. ⁶ Even if I am unskilled in speaking, I am not so in knowledge; indeed, in every way we have made this plain to you in all things. ⁷Or did I commit a sin in humbling myself so that you might be exalted, because I preached **God's gospel** to you free of charge?

Galatians:1: ⁵to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen. ⁶I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a **different gospel**— ⁷not that there is another one, **but there are some** who trouble you and want to **distort the gospel of Christ.**

Galatians 3: ⁸And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, **preached the gospel** beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations (*gentiles*) be blessed."

Matthew 4:²³ And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming **THE GOSPEL** (*good news*) **OF THE KINGDOM** and healing every disease and every affliction among the people.

Matthew 9:³⁵ And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming **the gospel** (*good news*) **of the kingdom** and healing every disease and every affliction.

Acts 20:¹⁷Now from Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called the elders of the church to come to him. ¹⁸And when they came to him, he said to them: "You yourselves know how I lived among you the whole time from the first day that I set foot in Asia, ¹⁹ serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials that happened to me through the plots of the Jews; ²⁰how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house to house, ²¹ testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. ²²And now, behold, I am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the Spirit, not knowing what will happen to me there, ²³except that the Holy Spirit testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and afflictions await me. ²⁴But I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, **to** testify to **the gospel of the grace of God**. ²⁵And now, behold, I know that none of you among whom I have gone about **proclaiming the kingdom** will see my face again. ²⁶Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all of you, ²⁷for I did not shrink **from declaring to you the whole counsel of God**.

Romans 15: ⁸For I tell you that Christ became a servant to the circumcised to show God's truthfulness, in order to confirm the promises given to the patriarchs,

Genesis 13: ¹⁴The LORD said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him, "Lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are, northward and southward and eastward and westward, ¹⁵for **all the land** that you see I will give to you and to your offspring **forever**.

Isaiah 61:¹ The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring **good news** to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;² to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor, ----- (*Jesus stopped here*) and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn;

Luke 4:¹⁷ And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written,¹⁸ "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because **he has anointed me to proclaim good news** to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,¹⁹ to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

JESUS STOPPED READING.

²⁰ **And he rolled up the scroll** and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him.²¹ And he began to say to them, "**Today this Scripture** has been fulfilled in your hearing."

Matthew 24:¹⁴ And this **gospel of the kingdom** will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

Mark 1:¹ The beginning of the **gospel of Jesus Christ**, the Son of God.

⁹ In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.

¹⁰ And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove.

¹¹ And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.

¹² The Spirit immediately drove him out into the wilderness.¹³ And he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.¹⁴ Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, **proclaiming the gospel of God**,¹⁵ and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and **the kingdom of God is at hand**; **repent and believe in the gospel.**"

Matthew 19: ²³And Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly, I say to you, only with difficulty will a rich person enter **the kingdom of heaven**. ²⁴ Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter **the kingdom of God."**

Luke 20: ¹ One day, as Jesus was teaching the people in the temple and **preaching the gospel**, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders came up

Galatians 1: ⁶I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the **grace of Christ** and are **turning** to a **different gospel**—

⁷ not that there is **ANOTHER ONE**, but there **are some who trouble** you **and want to distort the gospel of Christ**. ⁸But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you **a gospel contrary** to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. ⁹As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you **a gospel contrary** to the one you received, let him be accursed. ¹⁰For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be **a servant of Christ**. (*THE Messiah*)

John 14: ¹⁰Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, **but the Father who dwells in me does his works**.

John 17: ⁸**For I have given them the words that you gave me**, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me.

Acts 1: ²until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. ³ He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, **appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.**
