1 Corinthians 4: ⁶I have applied all these things to myself and Apollos for your benefit, brothers, **that you may learn by us NOT to go beyond what is written**, that none of you may be puffed up in favor of one against another.

(Zechariah 6:11-14)

Genesis 14: ¹⁸And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. (He was priest of God Most High.) ¹⁹And he **blessed him** and said, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth;

Hebrews 7: ⁴See how great this man *(Melchizedek)* was to whom Abraham the patriarch gave a tenth of the spoils! ⁵And those descendants of Levi who receive the priestly office have a commandment in the law to take tithes from the people, that is, from their brothers, though these also are descended from Abraham. ⁶But this man who does not have his descent from them received tithes from Abraham and blessed him who had the promises. ⁷It is beyond dispute that the inferior is blessed by the superior.

1 Corinthians 15: ⁵¹Behold! I tell you a mystery. **We shall NOT ALL SLEEP**, **BUT** we shall **ALL BE CHANGED**, ⁵²in a **moment** (atomō-an indivisible moment of time), in the twinkling (ripē - an instant) of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. ⁵³For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. ⁵⁴When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

Genesis 6: ¹⁹And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall **bring two of every sort** into the ark to keep them alive with you. They shall be male and female.

Genesis 7: ²Take with you seven pairs of all clean animals, the male and his mate, and a pair of the animals that are not clean, the male and his mate, ³and seven pairs of the birds of the heavens also, male and female, to keep their offspring alive on the face of all the earth.

Matthew 2: ¹Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, ²saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

¹⁰When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy. ¹¹And going into the house they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, **gold** and **frankincense** and **myrrh**.

Genesis 6: ⁷So the LORD said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them." ⁸But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. ⁹These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a **righteous** man, **blameless** in his generation. **Noah walked with God**.

¹¹Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence. ¹²And God saw the earth, and behold, it was corrupt, for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.

¹³And God **said to Noah**,

¹⁴Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and out with pitch. ¹⁵This is how you are to make it:......

¹⁷ For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life under heaven. **Everything that is on the earth shall die.**

Matthew 18: ³And he said: "I tell you the truth, UNLESS YOU CHANGE and become like little children, you will NEVER enter the kingdom of heaven.

Genesis 7: ¹Then the LORD said to Noah, "Go into the ark, <u>you</u> and all <u>your</u> household, for I have seen <u>that <u>YOU</u> are righteous before me in this generation.</u>

⁷And Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives **with him went into the ark** to escape the waters of the flood.

Psalm 96: ³ Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples. ¹⁰ Say among the nations, "The LORD reigns." The world is firmly established, it cannot be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity.

1 Peter 4: ¹⁶Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that name. ¹⁷For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and IF it begins WITH US, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? ¹⁸And "If the righteous is scarcely saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?"

If – ei – should always be translated "if" – since the assumption may only be portrayed as valid (true, factual). (followed by any verb) expresses "a condition, thought of as real, or to denote assumptions"
