**1 Corinthians 7: 35** This I say for your own benefit; not to put a restraint upon you, but to promote what is appropriate and to SECURE undistracted devotion to the Lord.

**Matthew 19:10-11 10** The disciples \*said to Him, "If the relationship of the man with his wife is like this, it is better not to marry." 11 But He said to them, "Not all men can accept this statement, but only those to whom it has been given.

**Titus 2:11-15** 11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men,

- All without exception is everyone, excludes nobody.
- All with distinction is limited to those, everyone within a specific group.

**John 10:1-5** 1 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber. 2 But he who enters by the door is a shepherd of the sheep. 3 To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. 4 When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice. 5 A stranger they simply will not follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers."

**Luke 12:35-37 35** "Be dressed in readiness, and keep your lamps lit. 36 Be like men who are waiting for their master when he returns from the wedding feast, so that they may immediately open the door to him when he comes and knocks. 37 Blessed are those slaves whom the master will find on the alert when he comes; truly I say to you, that he will gird himself to serve, and have them recline at the table, and will come up and wait on them.

**Luke 12:45-46 45** But if that slave says in his heart, 'My master will be a long time in coming,' and begins to beat the slaves, both men and women, and to eat and drink and get drunk; 46 the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not know, and will cut him in pieces, and assign him a place with the unbelievers.

**Titus 2:14-15 14** who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. 15 These things speak and exhort and reprove with all authority. Let no one disregard you.

**Hebrews 4:14-16** 14 Therefore, since we have (present active tense) a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have (present active tense) a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been (past tense) tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. 16 Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
