

## Jesus Christ Our Great High Priest

### Part 15 The 3 Oathds of God

#### **1 Chronicles 29:11-13**

11 Yours, O LORD, is the greatness  
AND the power  
AND the glory  
AND the victory  
AND the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens  
AND the earth; Yours is the dominion, O LORD,  
AND You exalt Yourself as head over all. 12 Both riches and honor come from You,  
AND You rule over all,  
AND in Your hand is power  
AND might;  
AND it lies in Your hand to make great  
AND to strengthen everyone. 13 Now therefore, our God, we thank You,  
AND praise Your glorious name.

#### **Matthew 24:29-31**

29 "But immediately after the tribulation of those days THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED,  
AND THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT,  
AND THE STARS WILL FALL from the sky,  
AND the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 30  
AND then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky,  
AND then all the tribes of the earth will mourn,  
AND they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power  
and great glory. 31  
AND He will send forth His angels with A GREAT TRUMPET  
AND THEY WILL GATHER TOGETHER His elect from the four winds, from one end of the  
sky to the other.

#### **Matthew 1:1**

1 The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham:

#### **Abraham:**

**Hebrews 9:11.** But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation;

**Hebrews 6:13-20**

13 For when God made the promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, 14 saying, "I WILL SURELY BLESS YOU AND I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOU." 15 And so, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise. 16 For men swear by one greater than themselves, and with them an oath given as confirmation is an end of every dispute. 17 In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the **HEIRS OF THE PROMISE** the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath, 18 so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. 19 This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one which enters within the veil, 20 where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, having become a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

**Galatians 3:16-18**

16 Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as referring to many, but rather to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ. 17 What I am saying is this: the Law, which came four hundred and thirty years later, does not invalidate a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to nullify the promise. 18 For if the **INHERITANCE** is based on law, it is no longer based on a promise; BUT God has granted it to Abraham by means of a promise.

**Genesis 12:1-3**

1 Now the LORD said to Abram,  
"Go forth from your country,  
AND from your relatives  
AND from your father's house,  
To the land which I WILL show you;

2 AND I WILL make you a great nation,  
AND I WILL bless you,  
AND make your name great;  
AND so you SHALL be a blessing;

3 AND I WILL bless those who bless you,  
AND the one who curses you I WILL curse.  
AND in you all the families of the earth WILL be blessed."

**Genesis 22:15-18**

15 Then the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a **SECOND TIME** from heaven, 16 and said, "By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have DONE this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son, 17 indeed I WILL greatly bless you, AND I WILL greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens AND as the sand which is on the seashore; AND your seed SHALL possess the gate of their enemies. 18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have **OBEYED** My voice."

**Galatians 3:16-18**

16 Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as referring to many, but rather to one, "**And to your seed,**" that is, **Christ**. 17 What I am saying is this: the Law, which came four hundred and thirty years later, does not invalidate a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to nullify the promise. 18 For if the inheritance is based on law, it is no longer based on a promise; but God has granted it to Abraham by means of a promise.

**DAVID:****2 Samuel 7:1-17**

1 Now it came about when the king lived in his house, and the LORD had GIVEN HIM REST on every side from all his enemies, 2 that the king said to Nathan the prophet, "See now, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwells within tent curtains." 3 Nathan said to the king, "Go, DO all that is in your mind, for the LORD is with you." 4 But in the same night the word of the LORD came to Nathan, saying, 5 "Go and say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD, "Are you the one who should build Me a house to dwell in? 6 For I have not dwelt in a house since the day I brought up the sons of Israel from Egypt, even to this day; but I have been moving about in a tent, even in a tabernacle. 7 Wherever I have gone with all the sons of Israel, did I speak a word with one of the tribes of Israel, which I commanded to shepherd My people Israel, saying, "Why have you not built Me a house of cedar?"'" 8 "Now therefore, thus you shall say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, to be ruler over My people Israel. 9 I have been with you wherever you have gone and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I WILL make you a great name, like the names of the great men who are on the earth. 10 I WILL also appoint a place for My people Israel AND WILL plant them, that they may live in their own place and not be disturbed again, nor WILL the wicked afflict them any more as formerly, 11 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel; AND I WILL give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also declares to you that the LORD WILL make a house for you.

12 When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I WILL raise up your descendant after you, who WILL come forth from you, AND I WILL establish his kingdom. 13 He shall build a house for My name, AND I WILL establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 I WILL be a father to him AND he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I WILL correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men, 15 but My lovingkindness SHALL not depart from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. 16 Your house AND your kingdom SHALL endure before Me forever; your throne SHALL be established forever." 17 In accordance with all these words AND all this vision, so **Nathan** spoke to David.

**16 Your house and your kingdom SHALL endure before Me forever; your throne SHALL be established forever."**

### **Acts 2:29-32**

29 "Brethren, I may confidently say to you regarding the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. 30 And so, because he was a prophet and knew that **GOD HAD SWORN TO HIM WITH AN OATH TO SEAT one OF HIS DESCENDANTS ON HIS THRONE**, 31 he looked ahead and spoke of the resurrection of the Christ, that HE WAS NEITHER ABANDONED TO HADES, NOR DID His flesh SUFFER DECAY. 32 This Jesus God raised up again, to which we are all witnesses.

### **2 Samuel 7:11-14**

11 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel; and I WILL give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also declares to you that the LORD WILL make a house for you. 12 When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I WILL raise up your descendant after you, who WILL come forth from you, and I WILL establish his kingdom. 13 He SHALL build a house for My name, and I WILL establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 I WILL be a father to him and he WILL be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I WILL correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men,

### **Psalms 89:3-4**

3 "I have made a covenant with My chosen;  
I have sworn to David My servant,  
4 I will establish your seed forever  
And build up your throne to all generations."  
Selah.

## **Jesus Christ:**

### **Isaiah 9:6-7**

6 For a child will be born to us, a son WILL be given to us;  
AND the government WILL rest on His shoulders;  
AND His name WILL be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,  
Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

7 There WILL be no end to the increase of His government or of peace,  
On the throne of David AND over his kingdom,  
To establish it AND to uphold it with justice AND righteousness  
From then on AND forevermore.

The zeal of the LORD of hosts WILL accomplish this.

### **Psalms 110:4**

4 The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind,  
"You are a priest forever  
According to the order of Melchizedek."

## **SUMMARY:**

**Lord's oath to Abraham - a people forever**

**Lord's oath to David - a throne forever**

**Lords oath to Jesus Christ - a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek**

### **John 10:1-3**

1 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber. 2 But he who enters by the door is a shepherd of the sheep. 3 To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.
