1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator also **BETWEEN** God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

Galatians 1:11-12

11 For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. 12 For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 1:1-2

1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bond-servants, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and communicated it by His angel to His bond-servant John, 2 who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw.

Revelation 12:7-8

7 And there was war in heaven, Michael and his ANGELS waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war, 8 and they were not strong enough, and there was no longer a place found for them in heaven.

Jude 1:9

9 But Michael the archangel, when he disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, did not dare pronounce against him a railing judgment, but said, "The Lord rebuke you!"

Numbers 14:30

30 Surely you shall not come into the land in which I swore to settle you, except Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun.

Hebrews 4:14-16

14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. 16 Therefore let us **DRAW NEAR** with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of **need**.

Hebrews 4:12-13

12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.

Here are the reasons stated that we can draw near with confidence;

1. The word of God is able to judge our thoughts and the intentions of our hearts
2. Nothing is hidden from Him
3. All things are open and laid bare to Him

1 Peter 3:22

22 who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, after angels and authorities and powers had been subjected to Him.

Hebrews 1:4-6

4 having become as much better than the angels, as He has inherited a more excellent name than they.

5 For to which of the angels did He ever say,

“YOU ARE MY SON,

TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU”?

And again,

“I WILL BE A FATHER TO HIM

AND HE SHALL BE A SON TO ME”?

6 And **WHEN** He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says,

“AND LET ALL THE ANGELS OF GOD WORSHIP HIM.”

Luke 1:30-33

30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God.

31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will (Future tense) give Him the throne of His father David; 33 and He will (Future) reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will (again future) have no end."

John 18:37

Therefore Pilate said to Him, "So You are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say correctly that I am a king. For this.....

I have been born, and for this I have come into the world,

to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

Hebrews 2:8

8 You have put all things in subjection under his feet."

For in subjecting all things to him, He left nothing that is not subject to him. **BUT NOW** we do **NOT YET** see all things subjected to him.

2 Corinthians 4:4

4 in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

1 Corinthians 15:23-28

23 But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, **AFTER** that those who are Christ's at His coming, 24 **THEN** comes the end, **WHEN** He hands over the kingdom to the God and Father, **WHEN** He has abolished all rule and all authority and power.

25 For He must reign **UNTIL** He has put all His enemies under His feet.

26 The last enemy that **WILL** be abolished is death.

27 For He has put all things in subjection under His feet. But **WHEN** He says, "All things are put in subjection," it is evident that He is excepted who put all things in subjection to Him. 28 **WHEN** all things are subjected to Him, **THEN** the Son Himself also **WILL** be subjected to the One who subjected all things to Him, so that God may be all in all.

Matthew 25:31 "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.
