Worshiping Our God In The Assembly Part 12 Being Water Baptized INTO The Body of Christ

Luke 6:46. "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and DO not DO what I say?

Luke 7:29 When all the people and the tax collectors heard this, they acknowledged God's justice, having been baptized with the baptism of John.

30. But the Pharisees and the lawyers rejected (to do away with what has been laid down, set aside) **God's PURPOSE for themselves, NOT having been baptized by John.**

Matthew 15:9. 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'"

Matthew 3:11. "As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Mark 1:8. I baptized you with water; but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

Luke 3:16. John answered and said to them all, "As for me, I baptize you with water; but One is coming who is mightier than I, and I am not fit to untie the thong of His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

John 1:32-34

32 John testified saying, "I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He remained upon Him. 33 I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.' 34 I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God."

Luke 7:30. But the Pharisees and the lawyers rejected God's purpose for themselves, not having been baptized by John.

John 1:33. I did not recognize Him, **but He who SENT ME to baptize in water** said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.'

1 Corinthians 15:42-49

42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body; 43 it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; 44 it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. 45 So also it is written, "The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING SOUL." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

46 However, the spiritual is NOT first, but the natural; THEN the spiritual.

47 The first man is from the earth, earthy; the second man is from heaven. 48 As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are heavenly. 49 Just as we have (past tense) borne the image of the earthy, we **WILL** (future tense) also bear the image of the heavenly.

1 Corinthians 12:12-13

12 For even as the body is **ONE** and yet has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are **ONE** body, so also is Christ. 13 For by **ONE** Spirit we were all **BAPTIZED INTO ONE BODY**, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were **ALL** made to drink of **ONE** Spirit.

Ephesians 5:22-32

22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the **HEAD of the church** (*eklessia*), He Himself being the Savior of the body. (*Singular*)

Ephesians 4:16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Ephesians 5:24-32

24 But as the **church** (*eklessia*) is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

25 Husbands, love your wives, **JUST AS Christ also loved the church** and gave Himself up for **HER**,

26 so that He might sanctify **HER**, having cleansed **HER** by the washing of water with the word,

27 THAT He might present to Himself the **church** (*eklessia*) in all **HER** glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that **SHE** would be holy and blameless.

28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; 29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also **DOES THE church** (eklessia), 30 **BECAUSE we are members of His body.**

31 **FOR THIS REASON** A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, **AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH.**

32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. (eklessia)

1 Timothy 3:15. but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church (*eklessia*) of the living God, **the pillar and support of the truth.**
