Acts 2:42-46

42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' TEACHING and to FELLOWSHIP to the BREAKING OF BREAD and to PRAYER.

43 Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place **THROUGH the apostles**. 44 And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common; 45 and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need. 46 Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart,

Acts 5:41-42

41 So they went on their way from the presence of the Council, rejoicing that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for His name. 42 And **EVERY DAY**, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ.

Acts 8:3 But Saul began ravaging the church, entering **house after house**, and dragging off men and women, he would put them in prison.

Acts 12:12 And when he realized this, he went to the **HOUSE** of Mary, the mother of John who was also called Mark, where many were gathered together and were praying.

Acts 20:18-21

18 And when they had come to him, he said to them,

"You yourselves know, from the first day that I set foot in Asia, how I was with you the whole time, 19 SERVING the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews;

20 how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly and from house to house, 21 solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Acts 21:27-29

27 When the seven days were almost over, the Jews from Asia, upon seeing him in the temple, began to stir up all the crowd and laid hands on him, 28 crying out, "Men of Israel, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this holy place." 29 For they had previously seen Trophimus the Ephesian in the city with him, and they supposed that Paul had brought him into the temple.

30 Then all the city was provoked, and the people rushed together, and taking hold of Paul they dragged him out of the temple, and immediately the doors were shut.

2 Corinthians 6:14-18

14 Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? 16 Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said,

"I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM;

AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.

17 "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord.

"AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN:

And I will welcome you.

18 "And I will be a father to you,

And you shall be sons and daughters to Me,"

Says the Lord Almighty.

1 Corinthians 15:33-34

33 Do not be deceived: "Bad company corrupts good morals." 34 Become soberminded as you ought, and stop sinning; for some have no knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame.
