# Philippians 2:9-14

- 9 For this reason also, **God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him** the name which is above every name,
- 10 **so that** at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- 11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- 12 So then, my beloved, just as you have always **OBEYED**, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling;
- 13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.
- 14 Do all things without grumbling or disputing;




PRESENT – happening in the present ACTIVE – the person is doing the acting IMPERATIVE - it's a command, not a passive request

## **Daniel 12:1-2**

- 1 "Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over the sons of your people, will arise. And **there will be a time** of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation **until that time**; and **at that time YOUR people**, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.
- 2 Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground WILL AWAKE, these to everlasting life, BUT the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt.

#### Matthew 19:28-29

- 28 And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration **WHEN the Son of Man WILL sit on His glorious throne,** you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- 29 And **EVERYONE** who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or farms for My name's sake, **will receive** many times as much, and **WILL inherit eternal life.**



Inherit – future tense

34 "**THEN** the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, **inherit the kingdom** prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

#### Matthew 25:44-46

44 Then they themselves also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not take care of You?'

45 Then He will answer them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.'

46 These WILL go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

John 3:36. He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."



5 But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,

## 6 who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS:

7 to those who by perseverance in doing good SEEK (present-active) for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life;



Seek – present active tense

- 8 but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.
- 9 **There will be** tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,
- 10 but glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- 11 For there is no partiality with God.

**1 Timothy 6:16. who alone possesses immortality** and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen.
