Part 5 The Apostle Paul on Prayer.....continued

The WHO and The WHAT.

Hebrews 5:7

7 In the days of His flesh, He offered up both prayers and supplications with loud crying and tears to the One able to save Him from death, and He was heard because of His piety.

Matthew 26:36-39

36 Then Jesus *came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and *said to His disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." 37 And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be grieved and distressed. 38 Then He *said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me."

39 And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

Hebrews 5:8-10

8 Although He was a Son, **He learned obedience from the things which He suffered.** 9 And having been made perfect, He became to **all those who obey Him** the source of eternal salvation, 10 **BEING** designated by God as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

Romans 8:1

1 Therefore there is now no condemnation **for those who are in Christ Jesus.**

Romans 8:4

4 so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us, **who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.**

5 For those who are according to the flesh **set their minds** on the things of the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:9. However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, **IF** indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But **IF** anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

10 IF Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, **yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness.**

Romans 8:13-14

13 for **IF** you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but **IF** by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For all who are **being led by the Spirit of God**, these are sons of God.

Romans 8:26-28

26 In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words;

1 Timothy 2:5-8

5 For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, **the MAN Christ Jesus**, 6 who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time. 7 For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying) as a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

8 Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.

Romans 8:27 and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, **because He INTERCEDES for the saints according to the will of God.**

Hebrews 7:25. Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God **THROUGH Him**, since He always lives to make **INTERCESSION** for them

(intercession - same Greek word used here as in Romans 8:26).

Romans 8;28ff

28 And we know that God causes **ALL THINGS** to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

2 Corinthians 13:7ff

7 Now we pray to God that you do no wrong; **NOT that WE OURSELVES** may appear approved, **BUT** that you may **DO WHAT is right**, even though we may appear unapproved.

2 Corinthians 13:4. For indeed He was crucified because of weakness, yet He lives because of the power of God. For we also are **WEAK in Him**, yet **WE WILL LIVE** with Him **BECAUSE** of the power of **God directed TOWARD YOU**.

Ephesians 1:15-20

15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists **AMONG you** and your love **for ALL the saints**,

16 do not cease giving thanks **for YOU**, while making mention of **YOU** (*plural*) **in my PRAYERS; 17 THAT** the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to **YOU** (*plural*) a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him. 18 **I PRAY** that the eyes of **YOUR** (*plural*) heart may be enlightened, so that **YOU** (*plural*) will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, (*plural*). 19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might 20 which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 6:18-20

18 **With ALL prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit,** and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition **FOR ALL the saints,** 19 and **pray** on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains; **that in proclaiming it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.**

Philippians 1:9-11

9 And this I pray, that **YOUR** love may abound still more and more **in real knowledge and all discernment,** 10 so that **YOU may approve** the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ; 11 having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians 4:9. The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, **PRACTICE these things, and the God of peace will be with YOU.**
