

Prayer Inside and Outside The Assembly

Part 7 Barriers to Answered Prayer.

1 Corinthians 9:27 but I discipline my body and make it my slave, so that, after I have preached to others, I myself will (aorist-active-subjunctive) not be disqualified.

Galatians 1:6-10

6 I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel; 7 which is really not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! 9 As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!

10 For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a bond-servant of Christ.

Hebrews 10:19-31

19 Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place **by the blood of Jesus,**

20 by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us *(plural)* through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and since we *(plural)* have a great priest over the house of God,

22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

1 Timothy 3:15 but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church (*ekklesia-Assembly*) of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.

Hebrews 10:23-31

23 Let us (*plural*) **hold fast the confession of our hope** without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, **consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;**

Hebrews 4:14. Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, **Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.**

Hebrews 10: 24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

Ephesians 4:16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint **SUPPLIES, according to the proper working of each individual part, CAUSES** the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Hebrews 10:25 - 31

25 **not forsaking our own assembling together**, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

26 For if we (*plural*) **go on sinning willfully** after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,

Those being addressed:

1. I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God

2. It's Those who now have a great Priest over the household

3. It's The ones who are to draw near to God

4. It's Those having their hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience

5. It's Those who have received the knowledge of the truth

Hebrews 10:26 - 31

26 For if **WE** go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

27 BUT a terrifying expectation of judgment and THE FURY OF A FIRE WHICH WILL CONSUME **THE ADVERSARIES**.

28 Anyone who has set aside the Law of Moses dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses.

29 How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled under foot the Son of God, and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which **HE WAS sanctified**, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?

30 For we know Him who said, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." And again,**"THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE."** 31 **It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.**
