# Part 30 – Philippians 4:10-19 The SECRET of Contentment ....continued

## 1 Timothy 6:2-ff

2b.....Teach and preach these *principles*.

- <sup>3</sup> If anyone advocates a different doctrine, and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the doctrine conforming to godliness,
- <sup>4</sup> he is conceited *and* understands nothing; but he has a morbid interest in controversial questions and disputes about words, out of which arise envy, strife, abusive language, evil suspicions,
- <sup>5</sup> and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain.
- <sup>6</sup> But godliness *actually* is a means of great gain, WHEN accompanied by contentment.
- <sup>7</sup> For we have brought nothing into the world, so we cannot take anything out of it either.
- 8 And if we have food and covering, with these we shall be content.
- <sup>9</sup> But **those who want to get rich** fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction.
- <sup>10</sup> For the love of money **is a root of all sorts of evil**, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith, and pierced themselves with many a pang.
- <sup>11</sup> **But flee from these things**, you man of God; and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance *and* gentleness.
- <sup>12</sup> Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
- <sup>13</sup> I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate,
- <sup>14</sup> that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,

<sup>15</sup> **which He will bring about at the proper time**-- He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords;


#### **Hebrews 13:5-8**

- <sup>5</sup> Let your character be free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you,"
- <sup>6</sup> so that we confidently say, "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid. What shall man do to me?"
- <sup>7</sup> Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith.
- <sup>8</sup> Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday and today, *yes* and forever.
