

**Part 4 – The Sovereignty of Our God-The Book of Job
The Fundamentals.....continued. John 3:16**

Luke 6:46-49

⁴⁶ "And why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' **and do not do what I say?**

⁴⁷ "**Everyone** who comes to Me, and **hears My words, and acts upon them**, I will show you whom **he is like**: ⁴⁸ **he is like** a man building a house, **who dug deep** and laid a foundation upon the rock; and when a flood rose, the torrent burst against that house and could not shake it, **because it had been well built.**

⁴⁹ "**But the one who has heard, and has not acted accordingly**, is like a man who built a house upon the ground **without any foundation**; and the torrent burst against it and immediately it collapsed, **and the ruin of that house was great.**"

Romans 2:1 Therefore you are without excuse, every man of you who passes judgment, for in that you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.

Romans 1:6-7,15

⁶ among whom **you also are the called of Jesus Christ;** WOW!

⁷ to all **who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints**: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

¹⁵ So, for my part, I am eager **to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome.**

Romans 1:18-20

¹⁸ **For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,**

¹⁹ because that which is known about **God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.**

²⁰ **For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.**

Romans 2:2-11

² And we know that **the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things.**

³ And do you suppose this, O man, when you pass judgment upon those who **practice such things** and **do the same yourself, that you will escape the judgment of God?**

⁴ Or do you **hold his priceless kindness, forbearance, and patience** in low esteem, **unaware that the kindness of God would lead you to repentance?**

⁵ But because of your **stubbornness and unrepentant heart** you are **storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath** and revelation of the **righteous judgment of God,**

Romans 2:6-8

⁶ who will **render to every man according to his deeds:**

⁷ to those who by perseverance **in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality** (*imperishability*), **eternal life;**

The Greek word for immortality only occurs in 1 Corinthians 15:53, 54 and 1 Timothy 6:16. So this verse 7 has been wrongly translated, it is often assumed these two words are synonymous they are not. Being clothed with imperishability happens immediately to those resurrected to life immediately in the resurrection of first importance THEN at a later time they are clothed with immortality prior to the new heaven and earth being brought to pass.

⁸ but to those who are selfishly ambitious and **do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.**

⁹ **There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil,** of the Jew first and also of the Greek,

¹⁰ **but glory and honor and peace to every man who does good,** to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

¹¹ **For there is no partiality with God.**

Deuteronomy 12: ³¹ You shall not worship the LORD, your God, that way, because they offered to their gods **every abomination that the LORD detests**, even burning their sons and daughters to their gods.

Psalm 11: ⁵ The LORD tests the righteous and the wicked, And the one who loves violence **His soul hates**.

Psalm 5: ⁵ You are not a god who delights in evil; no wicked person finds refuge with you;

Proverbs 6:16....ff

¹⁶ There are six things which **the LORD hates**, Yes, seven which are an **abomination to Him**:

You can read them when you get home. Be sure you do that, we need to be focused on what the Lord hates, we will see that as we move on here.

Malachi 2:16 For I hate divorce," says the Lord, the God of Israel, "and him who covers his garment with wrong," says the Lord of hosts. "So take heed to your spirit, that you do not deal treacherously."

Deuteronomy 7:9

⁹ Know, then, **that the LORD, your God, is God: the faithful God who keeps covenant mercy** to the thousandth generation **toward those who love him AND keep his commandments,**
