Job 33:13-33

“Half a truth is often a great lie.”

“Repetition does not transform a lie into a truth”.

“ A lie that is half-truth is the darkest of all lies.”

Job 42:7 It came about after the Lord had spoken these words to Job, that the Lord said to Eliphaz the Temanite, “My wrath is kindled against you and against your two friends, **because you have not spoken of Me what is right as My servant Job has.**

3. God is Transparent. Verses 13-17

Job 33: ¹³ **“Why do you complain against Him That He does not give an account of **all** His doings?”**

Hebrews 5:11-14 ¹¹ Concerning him we have much to say, and it is hard to explain, since **you have become dull of hearing.**

¹² For though by this time **you ought** to be teachers, you have **need again** for someone to teach you the **elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need **milk** and not solid food.**

¹³ **For everyone who partakes only of **milk** is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he is an infant.** ¹⁴ **But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.**

2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, **according to what he has done, whether good or bad.**

Job 33: ¹⁴ "Indeed God speaks once, Or twice, yet no one notices it.

Luke 13:1-5 ¹ Now on the same occasion there were some present who reported to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices. ² **And Jesus said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were greater sinners than all other Galileans because they suffered this fate?**

³ **I tell you, no, but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.** ⁴ Or do you suppose that those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them were **worse culprits** than all the men who live in Jerusalem? ⁵ **I tell you, no, but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish."**

Job 33: ¹⁵ "In a dream, a vision of the night,
When sound sleep falls on men,
While they slumber in their beds,
¹⁶ **Then He opens the ears of men,
And seals their instruction,**

Hebrews 1:1-2 ¹ God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Job 33: ¹⁷ **That He may turn man aside from his conduct,
And keep man from pride;**

Matthew 18:2-4 And He called a child to Himself and set him before them, ³ and said, "Truly I say to you, unless you are **converted** and become like children, **you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.**

⁴ Whoever then **humbles himself** as this child, he is **the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.**

Job 33: ¹⁸ He keeps back his **soul** from the pit,
And his **life** from passing over into Sheol.

James 5:11 We count those blessed who endured. You have heard of the endurance of Job **and have seen the outcome of the Lord's dealings, that the Lord is full of compassion and is merciful.**

Job 33: ¹⁹ "Man is also chastened with pain on his bed,
And with unceasing complaint in his bones;

²⁰ So that his **life** loathes bread,
And his **soul** favorite food.

²¹ "His flesh wastes away from sight,
And his bones which were not seen stick out.

²² "Then his **soul** draws near to the pit,
And his **life** to those who bring death.

²³ "If there is an angel as mediator for him,
One out of a thousand,
To remind a man what is right for him,

²⁴ Then let him be gracious to him, and say,
'Deliver him from going down to the pit,
I have found a ransom';

²⁵ Let his flesh become fresher than in youth,
Let him return to the days of his youthful vigor;

²⁶ **Then he will pray to God, and He will accept him,**
That he may see His face with joy,
And He may restore His righteousness to man.

²⁷ "He will sing to men and say,
'I have sinned and perverted what is right,
And it is not proper for me.

28 **He has redeemed my soul from going to the pit,**
And my life shall see the light.'

29 "Behold, **God does all these** oftentimes with men,

30 **To bring back his soul from the pit,**
That he may be enlightened with the light of **life.**

31 "Pay attention, O Job, **listen** to me;
Keep silent, and let me speak.

32 "Then if you have anything to say, **answer** me
Speak, **for I desire to justify you.**

33 "If not, **listen** to me;
Keep silent, and I will teach you wisdom."
